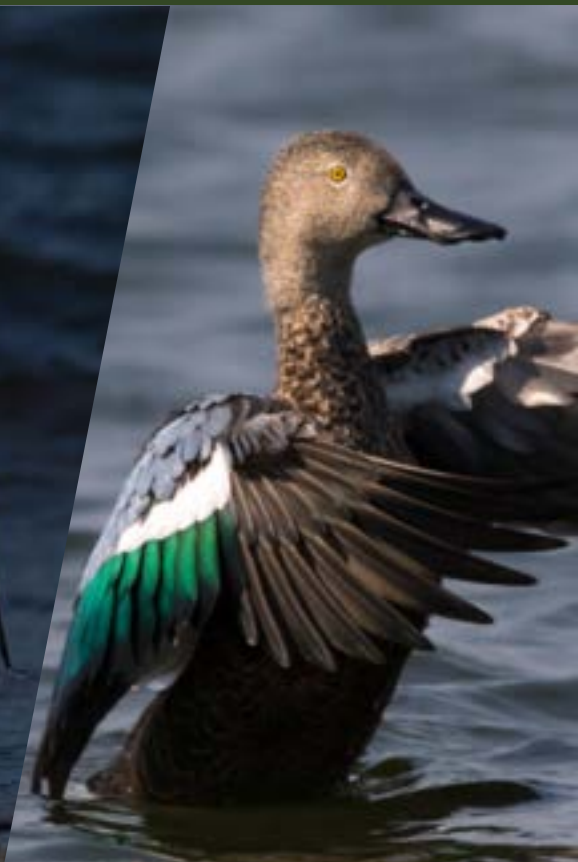
A CAPE TOWN DAY TOUR

This day tour takes us to the world famous Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, where we enjoy the large variety of birds that it attracts. We often have point blank views of two of the Cape's endemic species: the Cape Sugarbird and the Orange-breasted Sunbird as well as a chance to see the roosting Spotted Eagle Owls. The large pans of Strandfontein Wetland Reserve and the adjoining Rondevlei Reserve allow us to explore the wonderful array of wetland and coastal shrub habitat containing a host of different species. Time permitting, we can also include a visit to the African Penguin colony at Boulder's Beach.
